Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 04<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. 2. The **Revised agenda** before the Committee would be as under:-

- (i) Consideration of Private Member Bill further to amend the National Highways Safety Ordinance, 2000 [The National Highways Safety (Amendments) Bill, 2020] introduced by Senator Baharmand Khan Tangi in the Senate on 06-01-2020 and referred by the House to the Committee on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 for re-consideration and report.
- (ii) Briefing by the NHA on a Point of Public Importance regarding Non-E-Tag Vehicles crossing through E-Tag Lines on Motorway; raised by Senator Prof. Dr. Mehr Taj Roghani, in the Senate Sitting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2021 and same was referred by the House to the Committee for consideration and report.
- (iii) Discussion / Recommendations on the budgetary proposals of the Ministry related to Public Sector Development Program (PSDP) for the financial years 2022-23 in terms of sub-rule (7) of Rule 166 of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate 2012.
- (iv) Briefing by the NHA on the cost of construction of per kilometer road with comparison between the previous government and the present government on the rate of construction of roads.
- (v) Briefing by the NHA on the extreme rise in the amount of toll tax from Rs. 160 to more than Rs. 900 at M-2 (Islamabad – Lahore Motorway) and also submit a detail report separately on Toll Tax collection from M-1 (Peshawar-Islamabad Motorway), M-2 (Islamabad – Lahore Motorway) and M-3 (Faisalabad) Motorway etc. along with its spending detail.
- (vi) Criteria/policy for allotment of restaurants at rest areas on motorways and also brief the Committee on rate list of different items and price control mechanism established by NHA.
- (vii) Briefing by the NHA on the project of beautification and Plantation on the right of way owned by NHA and also provide the details of motorway/Highways on which this project has been completed.
- (viii) Any other item with the permission of the Chair.
