2. The agenda of the meeting would be as under:-

- i. What are the future plans of Government to reduce and pay-off the circular debt in gas sector?
- ii. Briefing on the demand of LNG of the country, why did the government reduce quantum of LNG import and future plans?
- iii. Briefing about the government's strategy and plans to handle the oil import and prices in the current scenario (Russian Ukraine Conflict).
- iv. Briefing on the policy and actions to maintain and ensure the fuel quality at the petrol pumps/outlets?
- v. Brief the Committee whether Rules allow the OMCs to mix HOBC97 to sell it on lower price?
- vi. Brief the Committee how can Explosive Department bound the people to do business with a certain/ particular OMC? Which rule allow them to hold land registered lease for a certain OMC agreement? Is it not a monopolistic approach against the open market? Explain.
- vii. Briefing about the OGRA tariff's determination mechanism and end consumer prices of gas for different sectors?
- viii. Does OGRA has a mechanism to determine gas tariff/ end consumer prices sector wise at different rates and what type of fiscal benefit to the economy have been kept in consideration.
- ix. How does OGRA determine the quantity of gas supply to different sectors.
- x. Explain that when did the last audit of the Oil and Gas exploration companies done/submitted? Why these companies are not regularly paying GoP share on time and who will audit its expenditure and profit.
- xi. Why is there a discrimination between different sector by GoP in term of Sales Tax on different petroleum products.
- xii. Briefing about the oil and gas fields wherein section-4 has not been imposed, details of acquisition of land and rent being paid to the land owners in Balochistan.
- xiii. Briefing about the drilling for oil and gas being carried out by different companies in Kalat Division, present status of work on the same and details about the CSR activities carried out or being carried out by those companies in the adjacent areas of the said fields.
- xiv. Consideration of Senate starred question No. 125 regarding "provision of gas facility to Sirikot, Tehsil Ghazi, district Haripur" asked by Senator Syed Muhammad Sabir Shah and referred to the Committee for consideration and report during the sitting of the Senate held on 1st February, 2021.

- xv. Consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding gas load-shedding in the province of Balochistan and non-establishment of LPG Plants in Panjgor, raised by Senator Danesh Kumar and referred to the Committee for consideration and report during the sitting of the Senate held on 8th February, 2021.
- xvi. Consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding gas load-shedding in the province of Sindh, raised by Senator Saifullah Abro and referred to the Committee for consideration and report during the sitting of the Senate held on 8th February, 2021.
- xvii. Consideration of Public Petition No. 4103 of Mr. Ashfaq Sharif, resident of Solider Bazar, Karachi regarding gas shortage/load-shedding in Karachi, referred by Hon'ble Chairman, Senate to the Committee for consideration and report.
