 - viii. Consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding gas load-shedding in the province of Sindh, raised by Senator Saifullah Abro and referred to the Committee for consideration and report during the sitting of the Senate held on 8th February, 2022.
 - ix. Consideration of Public Petition No.4605 regarding complaint about meter tempering and overbilling submitted by Mr. Zahid Latif, Director, ZMB Trading (Pvt) Ltd. Lahore, referred by the Hon'ble Chairman Senate.
 - x. Any other item with permission of the Chair.
