Senior Managing Director, Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL), briefed the Committee on the issue raised in starred question No. 125 regarding "provision of gas facility to Sirikot, Tehsil Ghazi district Haripur". He informed that detailed survey was conducted for supply of gas to Sirikot in 2017 which was approved by the Federal Cabinet in 2018 with an estimated cost of approximately Rs.1 billion, wherein SNGPL had to pay an amounts of Rs.457 million whereas Rs.614 million had to be paid by the Government. He further stated that the Government funding required for the project was released in February, 2018, however, Finance Division withdrew the said amount on account of General Elections 2018 and thereafter the funds were lapsed. Consequently, work on the said project could not be commenced. On a query from the Committee, it was informed that the SNGPL's portion of funds for the scheme is intact.
- Senior Managing Director, SNGPL, also informed the Committee that funds amounting to Rs.4 billion against various similar projects have lapsed and are still pending with the Finance Division for release. In this regard, a Sub-Committee has also been formed in the National Assembly to look into non-release of funds by the Ministry of Finance for those projects. The Committee urged timely release of funds for such proper execution of such projects.
- **Recommendation**: After detailed discussion, the Committee, disposed of the issue raised in Senate starred question No. 125 with the recommendation that the Petroleum Division should take up the issue of non-releasing of funds for the scheme of gas supply to Sirikot, Tehsil Ghazi, Haripur with the Ministry of Finance on immediate basis.
