

4. The representative of SNGPL informed that Tehsil Ghazi has a gas network of 131 kms with 6800 consumers and four CNG stations. It is situated at the tail end due to which it faces gas pressure problem during winter season because gas consumption increases at upstream which puts pressure on the supply to tail end. He informed that there were also some issues caused due to road construction. He informed that the company deputed teams for pressure profiling and checking pressure round the clock to resolve the issue. He informed that the issue has now been resolved. Senator Syed Muhammad Sabir Shah expressed his satisfaction on the steps taken by the SNGPL for resolution of the issue. The Committee, therefore, disposed off the Point of Public Importance of the mover.
