The following Act of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 4th January, 1990, and is hereby published for general information :—

ACT NO. IV OF 1990

An Act further to amend the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Act V of 1908), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Code of Civil Procedure (Amendment) Act, 1989.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of First Schedule, Act V of 1908.**—In the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Act V of 1908), in the First Schedule,—

(a) in Order XXII, in rule 9, after sub-rule (2), the following new sub-rule shall be added, namely :—

“(3) The provisions of section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1908 (IX of 1908), shall apply to applications under sub-rule (2).”;

(b) in Order XLI.—

(i) rule 19 shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (1) of that rule and, after sub-rule (1) re-numbered as aforesaid, the following new sub-rule shall be added, namely :—

“(2) The provisions of section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1908 (IX of 1908), shall apply to an application for re-admission of an appeal dismissed under sub-rule (2) of rule 11 or sub-rule (1) of rule 17.” ; and

(ii) rule 21 shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (1) of that rule and, after sub-rule (1) re-numbered as aforesaid, the following new sub-rule shall be added, namely :—

“(2) The provisions of section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1908 (IX of 1908), shall apply to applications under sub-rule (1).”
