3. **SENATOR MIAN RAZA RABBANI**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Inter-Provincial Coordination, to move under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the subject matter of starred question No. 63 asked by Senator Mushtaq Ahmed on 3rd June, 2022, regarding the number of employees in Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) recruited on regular, contract and ad-hoc basis during the last five years indicating their salaries, allowances and other perks availed by them, may be extended for a period of sixty working days with effect from 2nd August, 2022.
