Rukhsana Zuberi, on behalf of **Senator Rana Maqbool Ahmad**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Cabinet Secretariat, moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 [The Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution (Amendment) Bill, 2022], introduced by Senator Kauda Babar on 1st August, 2022, may be extended for a period of sixty working days with effect from 30th September, 2022.
