 - b) Since the above named four Pakistanis were deprived of their freedom for up to two decades without any charge or trial, what steps could be taken on their behalf to seek compensation or reparation from the U.S. government under applicable U.S. and International laws, if any?
 - c) Data and information about citizens of Pakistan being held in prison in various countries across the globe, and what the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is doing for them in terms of ensuring protection of all their rights under applicable laws.
