REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS AND INTER-FAITH HARMONY

I, Senator Molana Abdul Ghafoor Haideri, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Religious Affairs and Inter-Faith Harmony, have the honour to present, on behalf of the Committee, this report on a Bill to regulate the system of moon sighting for commencement of Islamic Hijri calendar months "The Pakistan Ruet-e-Hilal Act, 2023". The Bill, as passed by the National Assembly, was moved by Senator Shahadat Awan, Minister of State for Law and Justice on behalf of Senator Muhammad Talha Mahmood, Minister for Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony, in the sitting of the Senate held on 30th July, 2023, and referred to the Senate Standing Committee on Religious Affairs and Inter-Faith Harmony for consideration and report thereof.

SUMMARY

4. The proposed legislation was discussed in detail. The Director General, Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony apprised the Committee that the Bill before the Committee to enact a law to provide for a mechanism to regulate the system of moon sighting for the purpose of commencement of Islamic Hijri calendar months and subsequently to bring harmony amongst

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followers of various schools of thought of Islam to perform their religious obligations with unanimity and for the matters ancillary. He further apprised the Committee that the Provincial Assemblies of the provinces of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan have passed resolutions under Article 144 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan to the effect that Majlis-e-Shora (Parliament) may by law regulate the matter of Ruet-e-Hilal.

- 5. After detailed deliberations, The Pakistan Ruet-e-Hilal Bill, 2023, as passed by the National Assembly, was unanimously approved by the Committee.
- Accordingly, the Senate Standing Committee on Religious Affairs and Inter-Faith Harmony recommends to the Senate that "The Pakistan Ruet-e-Hilal Bill, 2023" as passed by the National Assembly and transmitted to the Senate, may be passed. The copy of the Bill is annexed as Flag "A".

to regulate the system of moon sighting for commencement of Islamic Hijri calendar months

WHEREAS, it is expedient to enact a law to provide for a mechanism to regulate the system of moon sighting for the purpose of commencement of Islamic Hijri calendar months and consequently to bring harmony amongst followers of various schools of thought of Islam to perform their religious obligations with unanimity and for the matters ancillary thereto;

AND WHEREAS, the Provincial Assemblies of the Provinces of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan have passed resolutions under Article 144 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan to the effect that Majlis-e-Shora (Parliament) may by law regulate the matter of Ruet-e-Hilal;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement.— (1) This Act shall be called the Pakistan Ruet-e-Hilal Act, 2023.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions. (1) In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context.
 - (a) "chairperson" means a chairperson of the Federal Ruet-eHilal committee, and includes every chairperson of each
 Provincial Ruet-e-Hilal committee, appointed under this
 Act:

- (b) "Code" means the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898);
- (c) "district committee" ineans district Ruet-e-Hilal committee constituted by each Province in their respective districts under this Act;
- (d) "division concerned" means the division to which business of this Act stands allocated;
- (e) "electronic media" means shall have same meaning as assigned thereto in clause (he) of section 2 of the Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority Ordinance, 2002(XIII of 2002);
- (f) "Federal committee" means the Federal Ruet-e-Hilal committee constituted under this Act;
- (g) "ICT" means the Islamabad Capital Territory;
- (h) "ICT committee" means the ICT Ruet-e-Hilal committee constituted by the division concerned under this Act;
- (i) "member" means a member of a Ruet-e-Hual committee, appointed under this Act;
- (j) "month" means the Islamic Hijri calendar month;
- (k) "PEMRA" means the Pakistan Electronic MediaRegulatory Authority established under the Pakistan
 Electronic Media Regulatory Authority Ordinance, 2002
 (XIII of 2002);
- (1) "provincial committee" means Provincial Ruet-e-Hilal committee constituted by a Province under this Act;
 - (m) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act;

- (n) "provincial department" means a department of a Province to which business of Ruet-e-Hilal stands allocated;
- (o) "rules" means rules made under this Act;
- (p) "Shariah" means injunctions of Islam as laid down in the Holy Quran and Sunnah; and
- (q) "witness of moon sighting" means a person who provides information about the moon sighting in accordance with Shariah.
- 2. Words and expression used but not defined under this Act shall have the same meaning as assigned thereto under the Code or the Pakistan Penal Code (Act XLV of 1860).
- 3. Federal committee. (1) Within one month of the commencement of this Act, the division concerned shall, by notification in the official Gazette, constitute a Federal Ruet-e-Hilal committee, consisting of the Chairperson and members as specified in column (2) of the Table below, namely:-

- (2) The committee constituted under sub-section (1) shall be under administrative control of the division concerned with its headquarters at Islamabad.
- 4. Provincial and ICT committees.— (1) Within forty-five days of the commencement of this Act, each provincial department to the extent of that province and the division concerned to the extent of ICT respectively shall, by notification in the official Gazette, constitute a Provincial and ICT Ruet-e-Hilal committee.
- (2) Each Provincial committee shall consist of a Chairperson and twelve other members who shall be appointed, from the recognized *Ulema* of all schools of thought and a representative of the concerned Provincial department.
- (3) The ICT Ruet-e-Hilal committee shall consist of not exceeding seven members including the Chairperson thereof.
- (4) The ICT committee shall comprise the recognized *Ulema* of all schools of thought and a representative each of the division concerned and the Islamabad augaf directorate.
- 5. District committee.— (1) Within sixty days of the commencement of this Act, each Province shall constitute a district Ruet-e-Hilal committee in each district for the purposes of this Act consisting of six members by giving therein representation to Ulema of all schools of thought.

- (2) The district committee shall be governed under supervision of the concerned deputy commissioner or in his absence by such other head of the district by whatever name called.
- 6. Prohibition of private committees.- No committee, entity or organization by whatever name called, other than the Federal, Provincial and district committees for sighting the moon shall operate in all over the Pakistan or any part thereof.
- 7. Term of the committees. The term of Federal, Provincial, ICT and district Ruet-e-Hilal committees shall be three years.
- 8. Meeting of the committee. (1) The meeting of the Federal Ruete-Hilal committee shall be convened by its Chairperson on the 29th day of each
 month or at any time at his own or as directed by the division concerned.
 - (2) The meetings of the Federal Ruet-e-Hilal committee shall be held in Provincial headquarters and ICT on rotation basis as may be prescribed.
 - (3) The meetings of the Provincial, ICT and district Ruet e-Hilal committees shall be held simultaneously in their respective headquarters and districts.
 - (4) Proceedings of the committee shall be recorded in writing.
 - (5) The committee may co-opt any person or invite any expert to attend its meetings or deliberations, for the purpose of advising it on any matter under discussion however such co-opted or invited member shall have no right to vote.
 - 9. Term and functions of Chairperson. (1) The Chairperson shall discharge such duties and perform any other functions as are assigned to him under this Act and the rules made thereunder.

- (2) The Chairperson may resign from his office, by writing under his hand addressed to the secretary of the division concerned in case of the Federal committee and ICT committee and to the Provincial department in case of Provincial committee.
 - (3) The Chairperson of the Federal committee shall be appointed on rotation basis from the Provinces and the ICT.
 - 10. Appointment of members of Provincial and ICT committees.—
 The concerned Provincial department or, as the case may be, the division concerned shall appoint such person as member of the Provincial committee or, as the case may be, the ICT committee who has got Shahadat ul Alamia degree from an institute recognized by any of the Wafaqs recognized by Higher Education Commission (HEC) or who possesses a master degree in Islamiyat having a minimum of ten years experience in Shariah.
 - Provincial department in consultation with relevant deputy commissioner or as the case may be, such other head of the district by whatever name called shall appoint such person as member of the district committee who has got Shahadat ul Alamia degree from an institute recognized by any of the Wafaqs recognized by HEC or who possesses a master in Islamiyat having a minimum of seven years experience in Shariah.
 - 12. Removal of Chairperson and members of the committee. The Chairman and members of the committees may be removed by the division concerned in case of Federal committee and ICT committee and by relevant Provincial departments in case of provincial committees and district committees after giving notice of not less than seven days containing grounds for removal or on recommendation of the members of the concerned committee by vote of two-third majority.

13. Acceptance of witness for moon sighting. The Federal, Provincial, ICT and district Ruet-e-Hilal committees shall accept evidence regarding moon sighting only in accordance with Shariah.

Provided that the evidence of moon sighting under sub-section (1) shall for the purpose of announcement under section 15 be sent to the Federal committee by the ICT committee and the provincial committee directly and by the district committee through the concerned provincial committees.

- 14. Public institutions to act in aid of the Ruet-e-Hilal committees.

 All the relevant public institutions shall act in aid of the Ruet-e-Hilal committees.
- 15. Announcement of decision of moon sighting.- Only the Chairperson of the Federal committee or any member of the committee authorized in this behalf by the Chairperson thereof shall be responsible to announce the decisions of moon sighted or not sighted.
- 16. Punishment.- (1) Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be punished with fine up to five hundred thousand rupees.
- (2) Electronic media that broadcast the news of moon sighting before the official announcement of moon sighting under section 15 shall be liable to punishment of fine up-to one million rupees or suspension of their licences by the PEMRA or with both.
- (3) Any person of persons who give false evidence regarding moon sighting shall be liable to the punishment of imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to three years or with fine upto fifty thousand rupees or with both.

- 17. Cognizance of offences. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code, an offence punishable under section 16 shall be cognizable, non-bailable and non-compoundable.
- (2) No Court other than a Court of Sessions shall take cognizance of an offence under this Act except on a complaint of the Federal, ICT, provincial or district committees, as the case may be, made in writing, with reasons to be recorded in writing alongwith full particulars of the offence committed under this Act.
 - (3) A complaint made under sub-section (2) may be made upon the information received, either upon its own or otherwise, as the case may be.
- (4) The provisions of the Code, so far as not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, shall apply.
 - (5) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code, the Court of Sessions shall decide the complaint under sub-section (2) within a period of sixty days.
 - 18. Power to make rules. (1) The Federal Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
 - (2) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, such rules may provided for-

- (a) appointment, removal, qualification and the training of Chairman and members;
- (b) travelling and lodging expenses for the Chairman and members;
- (c) powers, functions and responsibilities of Chairman and members;
- (d) manner of coordination between the committees;
- (e) the manner of aid to the committees by the relevant institutions and
- (f) matters connected therewith or ancillary thereto.
- 19. Power to make regulations. The Federal, ICT, provincial or district committees may, by notification in the official Gazette, make regulations for the purpose to give effect to their functions.
- 20. Removal of difficulties. If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Prime Minister may make such order not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as may appear to him to be necessary for removal of the difficulty.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In order to regulate the system of moon sighting for the purpose of commencement of Islamic Hijri clander months and consequently to bring harmony amoungst followers of various schools of thought of Islam to perform their religious obligations with unanimity throughout the country.

2. The Bill seeks to achieve the aforesaid objective.
