SUBJECT: REPORT OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON INTERIOR ON THE PROVINCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2023 2023.

I, Senator Mohsin Aziz, Chairman Senate Standing Committee on Interior, have the honor to present report of the Committee on a Bill further to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicle Ordinance, 1965 [The Provincial Motor vehicles (Amendment) Bill, 2023] (Insertion of new section 101A), introduced by Senator Shahadat Awan on 6th November, 2023.

4. The Mover briefed the Committee that he had introduced this Bill earlier which was recommended by the Committee and report was also presented in the House but the same stood lapsed after he assumed the charge of the Minister.

The ICCPO Islamabad pointed out the para (b) of sub-clause (2) of clause 2 of the Bill which is vague as everyone can take its plea so that para needs to be omitted as it would be very difficult to ensure, manage and enforce. He was of the view that in para (a) the words 'other emergency services' have already been mentioned so 'emergency' at para (b) is open ended. He requested the Mover to review it and delete the same from the Bill.
- 6. The Committee also endorsed the point raised by the ICCPO Islamabad as para (b) becomes redundant when the word 'other emergency' is also mentioned in para (a).
- 7. The Mover agreed the suggestion of the ICCPO and the Committee made the amendment in the Bill and para (b) of sub-clause (2) of clause 2 of the Bill was deleted from the Bill.

R. Thereafter, the Bill was put to the vote of the Committee which was unanimously recommended by the Committee with the recommendation that para (b) of sub-clause (2) of clause 2 of the Bill may be deleted from the Bill. The Bill as introduced in the Senate is at Annexure-A. The Bill as reported by the Committee is at Annexure-B. The Committee also gave approval of presentation of report of the Committee to the House. Hence, this report is presented to the House.

TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE SENATE

further to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965 (W.P. Ordinance XIX of 1965) in its application to the extent of Islamabad Capital Territory;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Provincial Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2023.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Insertion of new section 101-A, Ordinance No. XIX of 1965.— In the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965 (W.P. Ordinance XIX of 1965), after section 101, the following new section shall be inserted, namely:-
 - "101-A. Use of mobile telephones.- (1) A person shall not drive a motor cycle or motor vehicle if he is using a hand-held mobile telephone or a device which performs an interactive communication function of transmitting and receiving data.
 - (2) A person shall not be guilty of contravention of sub-section (1) if, at the time of the alleged contravention, he is-
 - (b) using the mobile telephone or the device to call the police, fire, ambulance or other emergency service; or
 - (a) acting in response to an emergency."

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

According to the data of Islamabad Traffic Police, 13,747 drivers had been fined in the year 2021, against using mobile phones while driving. The data shows that there is an increasing trend especially amongst the youth to use their phones to text, voice calls and for video making while driving motor vehicles which sometimes leads to a harmful situation. Therefore, it is hereby proposed to add a new section to ban such practice and impose fines on the violators.

2. This bill seeks to achieve the above said purposes.
