[TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE SENATE] A BILL

further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 and the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860, (XLV of 1860) and the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (V of 1898) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) This Act may be called the Criminal Laws (Amendment) Act, 2024.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Insertion of sections 160A and 160B, Act XLV of 1860.- In the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 (XLV of 1860), after section 160, the following new sections shall be inserted, namely:-
 - **"160A. Preaching of Zionism.-** Whoever knowingly or intentionally is engaged in the preaching of Zionism to incite and provoke hatred in society, shall be punished with three years imprisonment, or with forty-thousand rupees fine or with both.
 - 160B. Display of Zionism Symbols.— Whoever knowingly or intentionally display symbols of Zionism to spread hatred and cause a disturbance in public peace, shall be punished with two years imprisonment, or with thirty-thousand rupees fine or with both."
- **3.** Amendment of schedule II, Act V of 1898.- In the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (V of 1898), in schedule II, in column I, after section 160 and corresponding entries relating thereto in columns 2 to 8, the following new sections and entries relating thereto shall be inserted, namely:-

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Hence, in the light of above, the said amendment has been brought.

2. This Bill is aimed to achieve the above-said objective.
