**BILLS TO INTRODUCED**

**1. Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri**, moved for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 [The Pakistan Penal Code (Amendment) Bill, 2024] **(Amendment of section 377 of PPC).**

**The Motion was put to the House and leave to introduce the bill was granted. The Bill introduced and referred to Standing Committee concerned.**

**2. Senator Palwasha Muhammad Zai Khan**, moved for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the protection, preservation, conservation and management of nature and wildlife in Islamabad Capital Territory [The Islamabad Nature Conservation and Wildlife Management Bill, 2024].

**7. Senator Aon Abbas,** moved for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan [The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2024] **(Amendment of Articles 1,51,59,106,154,175A,198 and 218 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan).**
