BILLS TO INTRODUCED
MOTION
[Under rule 263]

1. Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, moved under Rule 263 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the requirement of Rule 120 of the said Rules, be dispensed with in order to take into consideration the Bills at Order Nos. 4 to 11, as passed by the National Assembly.

The Motion was put to the House and Adopted.

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS
BILLS AS PASSED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, moved that the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation Act, 1973 [The Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation (Amendment) Bill, 2024], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration at once.

The Motion was put to the House. Thereafter, the House started second reading of the Bill i.e. clause by clause consideration.
