RESOLUTION

Senator Sherry Rehman, moved the following resolution:-

"The House unequivocally condemns the recent mob lynching in Swat and Sargodha person accused of offences pertaining to religion;

The right to life is the most fundamental right as guaranteed by the Constitution of Pakistan and must remain inviolable;

The House, therefore, urge the Federal and Provincial Governments to ensure the safety and security of all persons living in Pakistan, including religious minorities and vulnerable communities;

The House also demands the Provincial Governments of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Punjab to take all measures to ensure that the persons involved in these heinous crimes are identified, investigated and prosecuted without loss of any time;

The House also expects that the court dealing with these cases shall ensure justice as per timelines provided in the law."

The Resolution passed by the House.

3. Senator Saleem Mandviwalla, Chairman, Standing Committee on Finance and Revenue, to move that the recommendations on the Finance Bill, 2024, containing the Annual Budget Statement, as reported by the Committee, be adopted.
