
3. The Committee discussed on the privilege moved by Senator Saifullah Abro against SP Larkana, Mr. Faisal Chaudhry. Senator Saifullah Abro stated that the security which had been provided to member Senator Saifullah Abro by Sindh police had been withdrawn by S.P Larkana which caused a great security concern to him. Since then, he had tried many times to contact SP, Larkana Mr. Faisal Chaudhry from his cell and through his staff on his Cell No.


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0333- 3338886 and his office No.0749410412 to discuss the issue but neither he attended member's phone nor replied later on.

Ahmed Faisal Chaudhry the SP was asked the reason of withdrawal of police guard, he told the committee that it was beyond his authority to provide any guard to someone, and there is certain procedure to be followed to get such body guard. According to that procedure the provision of security is subject to the confirmation by the divisional threat assessment committee which evaluates the level of threat based on thorough risk assessment. Such technicalities were rejected by the committee on the ground that constitution of Pakistan under article 9 guarantees the security of person, thus right to life is fundamental right of every person. The state and its organ the government housed in home department Sindh is bound to provide for such security absolutely as a qualified right not conditionally. Furthermore the police officer was asked the reason for not attending the calls of honorable member for which he was unable to reply satisfactorily. However, the said police officer apologized from the member before committee. The member was pleased to accept the apology. The committee decided to dispose of the matter to the extent of the individuality of the officer but recommended that all the parliamentarians must be provided with the security guards by the Sindh home department without discrimination and without following any formality as the right to life is a qualified right of every citizen guaranteed by the constitution.
