



Later, he tried to call the Senator, however, he could not be contacted. He stated that it was not intentional and also apologized. The Committee while keeping in view the absence of the Member, send the written reply of the SSP to the Mover. The mover was absent in next two meetings too.

5. The agenda was discussed in meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2025 in presence of mover. Senator Saifullah Abro stated that the Mr. Bashir Ahmed hadn't responded to his calls after inquiry regarding kidnap of so many people in dist. Kindhkot.

6. SSP Kasmore Mr. Bashir told the committee that he has been transferred to Karachi in the unit of CIA these days. He explained that the days when honorable Senator Saifullah Abro called him, he was busy in kachha operation where seven police personal were martyred and eight got injured. I might have missed the calls of honorable senator for which I had already submitted a written apology before this honorable committee, however I again beg for pardon with a promise that I would be cautious for next time. Senator Saifullah Abro stated sorrowfully that I am feeling ashamed of the submission of pardon of an officer. Pardon is only to satisfy the ego which I'm not fond of getting it satisfied. My phone calls to the officer did not intend my personal cause, it was to discuss an issue of public importance regarding abduction of Mr. Shakir Shah who was released after satisfying the amount of ransom. Anyways committee taking a lenient view point and keeping the officers busy hours in Kaccha operation in mind accepted the apology of the officer and disposed of the matter with the direction that the matter of public importance should be dealt impartially, honestly, professionally, expeditiously, dutifully and beyond all biases and prejudices.

7. **Direction/Decision:** -The committee accepted the apology of SSP Kashmore disposing of the motion directed the police concerned that the matter of public importance should be dealt impartially, honestly, professionally, expeditiously, dutifully and beyond all biases and prejudices.
