BILL TO BE INTRODUCED

1. Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law and Justice, introduced a Bill to provide for establishment of Whistleblower Protection and Vigilance Commission [The Whistleblower Protection and Vigilance Commission Bill, 2025].

The Bill introduced and referred to Standing Committee concerned.

RESOLUTION FOR EXTENSION OF ORDINANCE

1. Senator Muhammad Tallal Badar, on behalf of Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi, Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control, moved the following Resolution:-

“That the Senate resolves to extend the Societies Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, 2024 (Ordinance No. XI of 2024), for further period of one hundred and twenty days with effect from 26th April, 2025, under proviso to sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of clause (2) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.”

The Resolution was passed by the House unanimously.

MOTION

[Under Rule 263]

1. Senator Danesh Kumar, moved under Rule 263 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the requirement of Rule 25 the said Rules be dispensed to enable the House to take up the Private Member’s Bill titled [The Nippon Institute of Advanced Sciences Bill, 2025] for consideration as forwarded by the National Assembly and Standing Committee of the Senate.

The Motion was put to the House and Adopted.

1. Senator Danesh Kumar, On Behalf Of **Senators Kamran Murtaza And Rana Mahmood UI Hassan,** moved that the Bill to establish the Nippon Institute of Advanced Sciences [The Nippon Institute of Advanced Sciences Bill, 2025], as reported by the Standing Committee, be taken into consideration at once.

The Motion was put to the House. Thereafter, the House started second reading of the Bill i.e. clause by clause consideration.

2. Senator Danesh Kumar, On Behalf Of **Senators Kamran Murtaza and Rana Mahmood UI Hassan,** moved that the Bill to establish the Nippon Institute of Advanced Sciences [The Nippon Institute of Advanced Sciences Bill, 2025], be passed.

The Motion was put to the House and the Bill was passed.
