  - v) Further discussion on Starred Question No. 3, asked by Senator Shahadat Awan in the Senate Session held on 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2024, regarding the trains accidents took place during the last five years; and whether any inquiry / investigation has been conducted regarding the said accidents, if so, the details thereof indicating also the action taken against those officials found responsible for the accidents?
