A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Power is scheduled to be held on Friday, the 23rd May, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. in Committee Room No.1, Parliament House, Islamabad.

2. The agenda of the meeting will be as under:-

- I. The Minister for Power to brief the Committee on provincial power dues adjustment via NFC.
- II. The Minister for Power to brief the Committee on current status of execution plan of privatization of DISCOs.
- III. The Minister for Power to brief the Committee about the recent decrease in price of electricity with particular reference to the components under which the recent decrease has been made e.g. the Fuel adjustment, quarterly tariff adjustment or cost of electricity etc.
- IV. The Minister for Power and Chairman NEPRA to brief the Committee on coal purchasing and coal pricing mechanism for the power sector in the country.
- V. The Minister for Power to brief the Committee on the proposed/planned working on special electricity tariffs to attract crypto mining and block chain-based data centers, aiming to utilize surplus power at marginal costs while fostering growth in the digital asset industry.
- VI. The Minister for Power to brief the Committee on the rationale behind the peak and off-peak hours for utilization of electricity by industrial and domestic consumers especially when there is surplus installed capacity of electricity in the country.
- VII. The Chief Executive Officer of IESCO to brief the Committee on following:
 - a) On overall working & performance of IESCO, ongoing Development and non-development Projects and further briefing on Advance Infrastructure Metering (AMI).
 - b) On the regularization of daily wages/contract/contingent employees of IESCO.
- VIII. The Chief Executive Officer, QESCO to brief the Committee on the following:
 - a. About the reasons of unannounced load-shedding exceeding eight hours in Turbat, Gwadar, Panjgur, and other areas of Makran, Balochistan, which is severely impacting daily lives of the citizens.
 - b. About the Makran Electricity Agreement signed by former Senator Lashkari Raisani, then Chairman of the Senate Standing Committee, during an official visit to Tehran, Iran, where it was agreed that residents of Makran would be charged Rs. 7 per unit. However, they are currently being charged Rs. 70 per unit.
- IX. Any other item with the permission of the Chair.
