


4. The Secretary, Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training briefed the Committee, stating that the Federal Directorate of Education governs and manages about 432 educational institutions. These institutions have a teaching strength of about more than 8500 in different categories and pay scales. There is a regular process of promotion of these teachers and since May, 2022 till date, 906 teachers have been regularly promoted. The process of promotion of teachers including high time scale promotion is smoothly working. Even recently on 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2025, 69 teachers were granted high time scale promotion. So the Ministry has a clear and consistent policy that once a teacher fulfill the requirement of promotion, he/she is promoted without any delay. He said that no complaint had been made by any teacher in this regard.

5. After deliberation, the Committee disposed of the said assurance and appreciated the efforts of the concerned quarters on the implementation of the said assurance in a timely and effective manner.

6. The Committee in its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2025, gave approval for presentation of this report to the House.
