


4. The Member NHA, North Zone explained that the condition of Peshawar-Islamabad Motorway (M-1) was surely bad in 2022. It was due to lack of sufficient funds for repair and rehabilitation. However since 2022, despite scarcity of sufficient funds, 134.5 km long part of M-1 Motorway, about which assurance was given on the floor of the House, has been repaired and rehabilitated. The Member NHA further elaborated that the repair and rehabilitation is a continuous process and is done subject to availability of funds.

5. After deliberation, the Committee disposed of the said assurance and appreciated the efforts of the concerned quarters on the implementation of the said assurance in a timely and effective manner.

6. The Committee in its meeting held on 29th April, 2025, gave approval for presentation of this report to the House.
