- v. Briefing by SNGPL regarding its development projects/schemes and extension in network completed or being carried out in District Charsaddah, Lower Dir, Mingora and Swat.
- vi. Detailed briefing by the MD OGDCL on the following:
 - a. Daily rental rates fixed for rigs and drilling rate per meter per day by OGDCL and its comparison with PPL, Mari Petroleum and other oil and gas companies for similar wells in both Northern and Southern regions and the reason of significant cost disparity, if any.
 - b. Total amount of loss per day due to forced gas curtailment and reasons of loss, individuals and departments responsibility in this regard and the future strategic plans of OGDCL to mitigate this financial burden and the role of Petroleum Division in the forced curtailment.
- vii. Any other item with the permission of the Chair.
