BILL INTRODUCED

1. Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law and Justice, on behalf of **Senator Ahad Khan Cheema**, Minister for Establishment, moved that the Bill further to amend the Civil Servants Act, 1973 [The Civil Servants (Amendment) Bill, 2025], as reported by the Standing Committee, be taken into consideration at once.
