PRIVILEGES ON PRIVILEGE MOTION MOVED BY SENATOR MIR DOSTAIN KHAN
DOMKI AGAINST MR. LAL JAN JAFFAR, SECRETARY COMMUNICATION & WORKS,
GOVERNMENT OF BALOCHISTAN**

I. Senator Syed Waqar Mehdi, Chairman Standing Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges have the honor to submit, on behalf of this Committee, this report on matter referred by Senator Mir Dostain Khan Domki Against Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar, Secretary Communication & Works, Government of Balochistan, referred to the said Committee on 19th December, 2024, for consideration and report.

3. The matter was in agenda of meeting held on 23rd January, 2025, but could not be discussed due to absence of Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar, Secretary CWPP & H Department, Government of Baluchistan.. The matter was discussed in meeting held on 21st March, 2025 but was deferred due to the absence of Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar, Secretary CWPP & H Department, Government of Baluchistan. A private secretary Mr. Abdul Ghaffar sent a request to exempt the attendance of the said Secretary from the meeting due to non-availability of tickets from Quetta and Karachi. This request was rejected by the Committee labeling the request as a lame excuse as the person is habitual absentee. The clear notice of intimation regarding the said meeting was issued on 13th March 2025 which is nine days prior notice to make it arranged to attend the meeting. An officer performing at the top of the hierarchy should be efficient enough to manage the travel from Quetta to Islamabad within such long interval between the notice and holding of the meeting. If his managerial skills are so feeble then the Chief Secretary must ponder the key posting of the said secretary who is not so proficient while the demand of the said posting is a proactive officer. 
Committee showed displeasure. The committee recommended the chief secretary may take stern action against the said secretary for his this non serious behavior and an unbecoming of an officer. The committee, in exercise of the power conferred in the rule 172B (6) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate 2012 was pleased to direct Chief secretary Baluchistan to require the attendance of Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar, before the Committee in the next meeting by soft or coercive measures.

The Committee discussed the Privilege Motion moved by Senator Mir Dostain Khan Domki against Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar, Secretary Communication & Works (C&W), Government of Baluchistan, whose repeated absence from Committee proceedings has raised eyebrows. "I made calls on November 11 and 12, but the Secretary did not answer," said Senator Domki. "Senator Faisal Sabzwari added, "He replied in writing that no calls were received, but Senator Domki has presented call records." The Committee expressed concern over "contradictory statements" and "non-responsiveness" by Secretary Lal Jan Jaffar, prompting strong remarks. In an unexpected turn, Secretary Lal Jan Jaffar apologized to Senator Domki during the meeting at first the Committee rejected apology and postponed the agenda for the next session for further examination and decided to write to the Chief Secretary Baluchistan seeking details of Lal Jan's recruitment and cadre change, along with a complete service record. Later on, after further discussion outside Committee room, the apology was accepted by the mover and matter was disposed of with the instructions to be more cautious next time.

5. **Direction/Decision:** - The Committee disposed of the matter by accepting the apology of Secretary Communication & Works (C&W), Government of Baluchistan, Mr. Lal Jan Jaffar with the instructions to be cautious next time and matter was disposed of.
