RESOLUTIONS

1. Senator Palwasha Mohammed Zai Khan, moved the following resolution:-

"This House strongly condemns the recent decision of the Israeli Parliament to approve a resolution asserting so-called Israeli sovereignty over the occupied West Bank, in brazen violation of international law, United Nations Security Council resolutions, and the Geneva Conventions.

Recalling that the West Bank is internationally recognized as occupied territory and that any unilateral annexation or claim of sovereignty is a clear affront to the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people,

Affirming the Government and the people of Pakistan's unwavering support for the just cause of Palestinians and the establishment of an independent and sovereign Palestinian State, in line with relevant UN resolutions and the Arab Peace Initiative. Recognizing that such actions by the occupying Israeli government gravely endanger peace and stability in the region and expose the expansionist and apartheid agenda of the Israeli regime,

This House

1. Rejects and denounces the Israeli Parliament's resolution as illegal, illegitimate and null and void under international law;
2. Demands that the international community, particularly the United Nations Security Council, take immediate and concrete action to halt Israeli expansionism and protect the rights of the Palestinian people;
3. Calls upon the Government of Pakistan to intensify diplomatic efforts in collaboration with the OIC and like-minded nations to resist and reverse such unlawful attempts;
4. Expresses solidarity with the people of Palestine in their rightful struggle for freedom, dignity, and self-determination."

The Resolution was passed by the House unanimously
