### REPORT OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON INTERIOR AND NARCOTICS CONTROL ON THE FEDERAL PROSECUTION SERVICE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2025 INTRODUCED BY SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALLAL BADAR, MINISTER OF STATE FOR INTERIOR AND NARCOTICS CONTROL IN THE SENATE IN ITS SITTING HELD ON 15<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2025.

1, Senator Faisal Saleem Rehman, Chairman Standing Committee on Interior and Narcotics Control has the honor to present on behalf of the Committee, this report on the Bill titled "The Federal Prosecution Service (amendment) bill, 2025 introduced by Senator Muhammad Tallal Badar, Minister of State for Interior and Narcotics Control in the Senate in its sitting held on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 and referred to the Committee for consideration and report.




4. The Prosecutor General, Islamabad informed the Committee that the Federal Prosecution Service Law was enacted in 2023. However, its jurisdiction was limited to the Islamabad Capital Territory only which needs to be extended to all Federal Courts established under any Federal

Law. Secondly, the 2023 Act stipulates that appointment of staff in the Federal Prosecution Service is to be made through the Federal Public Service Commission. However, recruitments through Federal Public Service Commission take considerable time. In order to strengthen the operations of the office of the Federal Prosecution Service, there is need of proper staffing on urgent basis. In order to overcome this problem, there is a need to make appointments on ad-hoc or contract bases till regular appointments made through the Federal Public Service Commission. He stated that the bill has been introduced to achieve both these purposes

5. The Committee after due deliberation and discussion unanimously recommended that the bill as introduced in the Senate maybe passed.

6. **Recommendation:** The Committee after discussion and due deliberation unanimously recommended that the Bill as amended/reported by the Committee may be passed. (*Bill as introduced in the Senate is placed at Annexure-A*).

Bill

*to further amend the Federal Prosecution Service Act, 2023*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Federal Prosecution Service Act, 2023 (LXV of 2023) in the manner and for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows,-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) This Act shall be called the Federal Prosecution Service (Amendment) Act, 2025.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

**2. Amendment of section 1, Act LXV of 2023.-** In the Federal Prosecution Service Act, 2023 (LXV of 2023), hereinafter referred to as "the said Act", in section 1,-

(a) in the marginal heading, after the word "title", a comma and the word ",extent" shall be inserted; and

(b) in sub-section (2), after the words "Territory", the word "and shall apply to all cases triable in the Federal courts established under any Federal Law" shall be added.

**3. Amendment of section 7, Act LXV of 2023.-** In the said Act, for section 4, for the full stop, at the end, a colon shall be substituted the following proviso shall be added, namely:-


"Provided that until recommendations are made by the Federal Public Service Commission, appointments to the service shall be made on ad-hoc or contract basis in the prescribed manner."

4. **Amendment of section 11, Act LXV of 2023.**- In the said Act, in section 11, in the marginal heading, for the word "Responsibly", the word "Responsibility" shall be substituted.

5. **Amendment of section 15, Act LXV of 2023.**- In the said Act, in section 15, in sub-section (2), in clause (c), for the word "fir", the word "FIR" shall be substituted.

**STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

Ministry of Interior and Narcotics Control under the Rules of Business, 1973 administers the Federal Prosecution Service Act, 2023. In order to stream line and make the Federal Prosecution Service more effective for dispensation of justice, the Federal Prosecution Service Amendment Bill, 2025 has been drafted. The same has been considered by the Federal Cabinet and approved for its introduction in the Parliament.
