"**WHEREAS,** Pakistan's maritime domain extends over 290,000 square kilometres, encompassing vital sea lanes, ports, and the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ), which are essential for national security and economic prosperity;

**WHEREAS,** the Pakistan Navy serves as the first line of defence for the protection of the country's maritime frontiers from Sir Creek to Jiwani, ensuring the safety of sea trade routes, energy supply lines, and coastal communities;

**WHEREAS,** recent regional developments, increasing cross-border tensions, and emerging non-traditional threats such as smuggling, maritime terrorism, and sabotage have underscored the urgent need to enhance Pakistan's maritime defence preparedness;

**WHEREAS**, credible reports have pointed to constraints in fleet readiness, maintenance and repair capacity, sensor and radar integration, and the need for accelerated modernization of naval platforms, submarines, and surveillance systems;

**WHEREAS**, the Pakistan Navy has demonstrated professionalism and courage in recent anti-narcotics and counter-sabotage operations in the Arabian Sea, successfully intercepting large caches of contraband and safeguarding Pakistan's maritime interests;

**Now, therefore, this House resolves that:**

1. The Senate of Pakistan recognizes and commends the Pakistan Navy for its unwavering dedication and outstanding contribution in defending the nation's maritime borders and ensuring the safety of Pakistan's sea lines of communication.
2. The Senate of Pakistan calls upon the Federal Government to ensure adequate budgetary allocation and technical resources for the modernization, maintenance, and operational readiness of the Pakistan Navy, particularly in the areas of:
  - i. Submarine and surface fleet repair and upgrade;
  - ii. Maritime domain awareness systems, including radar and sonar technology;
  - iii. Coastal and underwater surveillance infrastructure; and
  - iv. Integration of naval operations with the Air Force and maritime law-enforcement agencies.
3. The Senate of Pakistan reaffirms that a strong and well-equipped Navy is indispensable for safeguarding Pakistan's sovereignty, ensuring economic security, and maintaining peace and stability in the Indian Ocean region.
