

**REVISED NOTICE**

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2025. The meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Petroleum, scheduled to be held on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2025, at 02:00 p.m. in Committee Room No. 1, Parliament House, Islamabad, **will now be held at 11:30 a.m. on the following revised agenda; however, the date and venue of the meeting will remain the same.:** -

- (i) Consideration of Point of Public Importance raised by Senator Bilal Ahmed Khan, in the senate sitting held on 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2025, regarding shortage/load shedding of gas supply in Quetta, Balochistan, referred to the Committee for consideration and report.

  - (v) Implementation status of the recommendation no. iv of minutes of the meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2025, regarding "Provision of consolidated and analyzable dataset in (Excel format) on Kerosene, LDO, and Solvent."
  - (vi) Detailed presentation / briefing by Petroleum Division on Greenfield and Brownfield Refinery Policies, highlighting incentives for new investments and the upgradation of existing refineries.
  - (vii) Briefing by Secretary Petroleum Division / DG, Explosives Department, on the mechanism for SMC courses, including the rules, regulations, and procedures governing these courses, with particular reference to any irregular or unjust decisions that may have violated rights of senior officers or allowed the use of influence or unfair means in the selection process.

  - (ix) Consideration of application received from OGDCL employees regarding annual ACR's marked as "Average," adversely affecting their career growth and promotion.
  - (x) Briefing by the MD, SNGPL, on the new gas connections provided in Peshawar, Charsaddah, and Lower Dir, along with details of criteria, pending applications, and future plans for expansion of gas supply in these areas.
  - (xi) Any other item with the permission of the Chair.
