RESOLUTION FOR EXTENSION OF ORDINANCE

1. Mr. Aqeel Malik, Minister of State for Law and Justice, on behalf of **Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi**, Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control, moved the following Resolution:-

“That the Senate resolves to extend the Frontier Constabulary (Re-organization) Ordinance, 2025 (Ordinance No. VIII of 2025), for a further period of one hundred and twenty days with effect from 10th November, 2025, under proviso to sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of clause (2) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.”

The Resolution passed by the House.
