1. The Motion was put to the House and Adopted.

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

PRIVATE MEMBER BILL AS PASSED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND TRANSMITTED TO THE SENATE

1. Senator Sherry Rehman, moved that the Bill to establish an effective system of protection, relief and rehabilitation of women, men, transgender, children and any vulnerable person against domestic violence [The Domestic Violence (Prevention and Protection) Bill, 2025], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Motion was put to the House. Thereafter, the House started second reading of the Bill i.e. clause by clause consideration.
