MOTION

[Under Rule 126(7)]

1. Senator Saleem Mandviwalla, to move that the Bill to amend the Protection of Journalists and Media Professionals Act, 2021 [The Protection of Journalists and Media Professionals (Amendment) Bill, 2025], as passed by the Senate and transmitted to the National Assembly but not passed by the National Assembly within ninety days of its laying in the National Assembly, be considered in a joint sitting.

The Bill introduced and referred to Joint Sitting.

LAYING A COPY OF THE MONEY BILL

1. Senator Muhammad Aurangzeb, Minister for Finance and Revenue, to lay before the Senate a copy of the Money Bill further to amend the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 [The Income Tax (Third Amendment) Bill, 2025], as required under Article 73 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

The Money Bill stood laid, introduced and referred to Standing Committee of Finance and Revenue.

2. Senator Muhammad Aurangzeb, Minister for Finance and Revenue, to move that the Senate may make recommendations, if any, to the National Assembly on the Money Bill further to amend the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 [The Income Tax (Third Amendment) Bill, 2025], as required under Article 73 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

Presiding Officer, The proposals received for making recommendations on the Bill shall be sent to the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and Revenue which shall present its report within a period of 10 days.

M O T I O N
[Under rule 263]

1. Mr. Muhammad Ali, Adviser to the Prime Minister on Privatization, to move under Rule 263 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the requirement of Rule 120 of the said Rules regarding Notice period be dispensed with in order to take into consideration at once the Privatisation Commission (Amendment) Bill, 2025, as passed by the National Assembly.
