SENATOR SHAHADAT AWAN, Chairman, Standing Committee on Railways, to move under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the subject matter of Starred Question No. 1, asked by Senator Shahadat Awan, on 22nd May, 2024, regarding steps taken by the Government to control corruption in the Railways, may be extended for a period of sixty days with effect from 18th January, 2026.

AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE RULES

(Under Rule 278)

19. SENATOR QURAT-UL-AIN MARRI, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of Rule 278 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, to move the following amendments in the said Rules:-

- (i) in Rule 12, for sub-rule (8), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(8) Except with the permission of the Presiding Officer, a member shall not speak on the resolution for more than ten minutes:

Provided that the mover of the resolution and the Chairman or, as the case may be, the Deputy Chairman, against whom the resolution has been moved, may speak for twenty minutes.”

- (ii) for Rule 37, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“37. Time limit for speeches.- The Chairman may, after taking the sense of the Senate, prescribe a time-limit for speeches:

Provided that the Leader of House, or the Leader of Opposition, or Minister may speak for twenty minutes:

Provided further that the speech of any other member shall not exceed ten minutes.”

- (iii) in Rule 93, for the proviso, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided that the mover or, the Leader of House, or the Leader of Opposition, or Minister may speak for twenty minutes.”

- (iv) in Rule 227, in sub-rule (1), for the proviso, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided that a member with disability, illness, or any other condition affecting mobility may be permitted to speak while sitting:

Provided further that, notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Leader of House, or the Leader of Opposition, or Minister concerned may speak for twenty minutes:

Provided further that the speech of any other member shall not exceed ten minutes.”
