SENATOR ABDUL SHAKOOR KHAN, to draw attention of the Minister for Communication, towards the lack of basic amenities like public toilets etc. for the commuters traveling on N-10 (Gwadar-Karachi), N-25 (Karachi-Chaman), N-30 (Quaid Abad-Loralai) and N-40 (Chaman-Taftan) causing great hardships for passengers especially for the elderly, female and children.
