BILLS TO BE INTRODUCED

1. Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri, moved for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Federal Employees Benevolent Fund and Group Insurance Act, 1969 [The Federal Employees Benevolent Fund and Group Insurance (Amendment) Bill, 2026].

The Motion was put to the House and leave to introduce the bill was granted. The Bill introduced and referred to Standing Committee concerned.

RESOLUTION

1. Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law and Justice, moved the following resolution:-

"The Senate of Pakistan, being the House of the Federation:

"Strongly condemns the recent terrorist attacks in Balochistan and expresses deep condolences to the bereaved families while wishing a speedy recovery to the injured;

Pays tribute to the courage and sacrifices of the security forces and law enforcement agencies who continue to lay down their lives in the line of duty for the protection of citizens and defense of motherland;

Reaffirms the Senate's commitment to peace, development and political inclusion in Balochistan, recognizing that sustainable security is inseparable from socio-economic progress, good governance and respect for constitutional rights;

Reiterates the resolve of Pakistani Nation that terrorism shall not be allowed to succeed and that the unity of state and will of the people will prevail over all forces of violence, extremism and terrorism;

Urges the governments to ensure a transparent, swift and conclusive investigation into incidents and brings the perpetrators, facilitators and local and international sponsors of terrorism to justice in accordance with law;

Calls upon the Federal and Provincial Governments to further strengthen intelligence coordination, broader security, and counter-terrorism mechanisms, with special focus on Balochistan. "
