- (vi) Consideration of the PSDP projects (development and non-development) of the Ministry of Science and Technology proposed for the next financial year 2026-27, if any, to make recommendations, in terms of Rule 166(7) of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012;
- (vii) To review the following PSDP Projects proposed by the National University of Science and Technology (NUST) for the next financial year 2026-27:
 - a) Construction of Girls Hostel for 815 students at NUST under CDWP at a total cost Rs. 2239.245 million; and;
 - b) Construction of Girls Hostel for 420 students at NUST under DDWP at a total cost Rs. 2239.245 million.
- (viii) To review the status of PSDP projects of PCSIR approved by DDWP during FY 2023-24 & FY 2025-26; examine the reasons for delay in release of funds, and to discuss initiation of new projects of PCSIR in compliance with the Prime Minister's directives; and
- (ix) Any other item with permission of the Chair.


