

REPORT OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON INTERIOR AND NARCOTICS CONTROL ON THE POINT OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE REGARDING FAILURE OF POLICE TO ARREST THE MURDERERS OF HIS BROTHER AND NEPHEW RAISED BY SENATOR MUHAMMAD ASLAM ABRO IN THE SENATE DURING ITS SITTING HELD ON 25TH JULY, 2025.

I, Senator Faisal Saleem Rehman, Chairman Standing Committee on Interior and Narcotics Control have the honor to present on behalf of the Committee, this report on the on the Point of Public Importance regarding "Failure of Police to arrest the murderers of his brother and nephew" raised by Senator Muhammad Aslam Abro during sitting of the Senate held on 25th July, 2025 and referred to the Standing Committee for consideration and report.

3. The Committee took up the matter during its meetings held on 19th August, 6th & 25th November, 2025 and 20th January, 2026. The last meeting was attended by the following Members:


4. Senator Muhammad Aslam Abro informed the Committee that in 2023, his brother and nephew were killed in Defence, Karachi. He stated that they have no enmity or dispute with the culprits. Later on, it revealed that the culprits belonged to BLA and they are target

killers. The killers belong to the province of Balochistan and after the incident, they fled to that Province. He stated that the culprits are being supported by some of the police officers/officials of Balochistan, Police. The culprits are present at their residences but they are not being apprehended. He also stated that the one person arrested by the Sindh Police is not involved in the killing. He only provided vehicle to the killers on rent basis. However, the killers have not returned the vehicle to him. He also informed the Committee that he is facing security threats. About 6 months ago, an effort was made by the culprits to attack him. He informed the DIG, Islamabad Police about the threats. However, no action has been taken on his request so far for provision of security.

5. The DIG, West Karachi Police informed that the incident of the murder was committed in 2023. In the first FIR 3 persons were nominated which were later increased to 12. One person has been arrested while the rest are absconders. He stated that they conducted a raid with the help of Balochistan police in Quetta, however, they could not succeed in apprehending the culprits. They have requested the Balochistan Police for help. He further informed that they have initiated the process for freezing the properties of the accused and have also approached FIA to restrict their movement.

6. During the meeting held on 20th January, 2026, the the DIG, West Karachi Police informed that on the directions of the Committee, given by it in its meetings held on 6th and 25th November, 2025, the CNICs and Passports of the accused have been blocked and their bank accounts have been frozen. Further, proceedings for attachment of their properties are underway, pending responses from the Deputy Commissioners in Quetta and Mastung. Regarding mobile SIMs tracking, he informed that most of their previous contact numbers are no longer in use. The DIG, Quetta Police informed the Committee that they have provided full cooperation to the Sindh Police in the case and have conducted 13 raids on various locations to nab the culprits but without success so far. He assured that Balochistan Police will continue to extend full cooperation to Sindh Police in this case.


7. The Committee deplored that since 2023, the police have failed to arrest the culprits in this case. The Committee, however, showed satisfaction on the blocking of the CNICs and Passports and bank accounts of the accused. It directed both the Sindh and Balochistan Police to take concrete steps to nab the accused in this case at the earliest and send a report thereof to the Committee. The Committee also directed that the issue of threat to Senator Muhammad Aslam Abro may also be placed before the Threat Assessment Committees both in Islamabad and Sindh province and he may be provided with security in both places. The Committee disposed of the matter.




8. Recommendations: The Committee after thorough deliberation and discussion on the matter, made the following recommendations:

I. The Committee directed both the Sindh and Balochistan Police to take concrete steps to arrest the accused in the murder case of the brother and nephew of Senator Muhammad Aslam Abro at the earliest and send a report thereof to the Committee.

II. The Committee recommended that the matter regarding threats to Senator Muhammad Aslam Abro may be placed before the Threat Assessment Committees, ICT and Sindh province for provision of adequate security to the Member at both places.
