REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON RULES OF PROCEDURE AND PRIVILEGES ON PRIVILEGE MOTION MOVED BY SENATOR NAWAB UMER FAROOQ KASHI, ALONG WITH HON'BLE SENATORS AGAINST MISCONDUCT OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY, BALOCHISTAN, HOME SECRETARY, BALOCHISTAN, INSPECTOR GENERAL OF POLICE, BALOCHISTAN AND COMMISSIONER QUETTA ON 15TH AUGUST, 2025

I, Senator Syed Waqar Mehdi, Chairman Standing Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges have the honor to submit, on behalf of this Committee, this report on matter referred by Privilege Motion moved by Senator Nawab Umer Farooq Kashi, along with Hon'ble Senators against misconduct of the Chief Secretary, Balochistan, Home Secretary, Balochistan, Inspector General of Police, Balochistan and Commissioner Quetta on 15th August, 2025.

3. The Committee considered the said matter in its meeting held on 11th September 2025. Senator Kasi charged, "National institutions were aware of the abduction. If the Chief Secretary is unaware, why is he holding office?" The Chief Secretary Baluchistan shockingly remarked, "The Ministry of Interior Baluchistan is no longer of any use; it should be closed." The IG Baluchistan briefed that five terrorists out of a gang of nine had been killed. The committee summoned the former Chief Secretary and IG Baluchistan in their personal capacity to explain the failure of governance and security institutions. The committee recommended that in next


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meeting the Commissioner Hamza Shafqat of Quetta and Zahid Saleem then IG shall attend the next meeting.

4. The agenda was again discussed in meeting held on 17th November, 2025. Hamza Shafqat of Quetta ACS home and Zahid Saleem ACS Government of Baluchistan attended the meeting. On the pointation of Senator Nawab Umer Farooq Kasi, about the lapses of security the committee directed to make the security of Baluchistan in-surmountable in order to hold peace and harmony in the society.

5. The matter was disposed of in the meeting held on 17th February 2026, as it has been withdrawn on request of the mover.
