A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on **Housing & Works** will be held on Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 at 11:30 a.m. in Old PIPS Hall (PRC Hall), Parliament Lodges, Islamabad. In case of Senate session in the morning the meeting will be held at 2 p.m.

2. The **agenda** before the Committee would be as under:

- (1) **Compliance report by the following Ministries/Departments** who were directed by the Committee in the meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 to accept transfer of the remaining Pak PWD Maintenance Staff AND pay the salary and its arrears of last 7 months in pursuance of the Federal Cabinet decision notified vide the M/o. Housing & Works Notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 :

(1) M/o. Interior (Civil Defence), (2) M/o. Planning, (3) Auditor-General of Pakistan (AGP), (4) Director General, Intelligence Bureau, (5) Director General FIA, (6) Chairman FBR, (7) Executive Director, Jinnah Postgraduate Medical Centre (JPMC), Karachi, and Director, Border Health Services Pakistan, Karachi, and the Secretary M/o. National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination, Islamabad.

- (2) **Briefing by the Minister for Housing & Works**

the Secretaries of the following Ministries/Divisions/Department :

- (1) Cabinet Division, (2) M/o. Defence (PMD), (3) M/o. Religious Affairs, (4) M/o. Maritime Affairs, (5) Controller General of Accounts on;

Implementation status on the Federal Cabinet decision notified vide the M/o. Housing & Works Notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 regarding transfer of Maintenance Staff of Pak PWD to CDA, Estate Office and the other Ministries/Divisions/Department of the Federal Government.

**Para 2 (e) of this Notification binds the concerned Ministries/Divisions/Departments to complete transfer process of maintenance operations, record and staff by the deadline date of 30<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024** and this para specifically emphasizes, *“... However, the non-availability of any record shall not delay the transfer of enquiry and staff and it shall be listed as record to be provided.”*

- (I) Despite continuous efforts and meetings of the M/o. Housing & Works with the concerned entities to ensure immediate compliance of the Federal Cabinet's decision the non-compliant Ministries/Divisions/Departments to **give reasons for:**
- (A) Non-implementation and delay by the respective Ministries/Divisions/Departments;
- (B) Non-payment of salaries/pension, etc. to these employees since July, 2025 and deliberate delay in seeking funds from the M/o. Finance for FY 2025-26 for the payment of salaries, pension, etc.
- (II) (A) The concerned non-compliant Ministries/Divisions/Departments to **provide a deadline date to fully comply with the Cabinet decision** as conveyed through the M/o. Housing & Works Notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024.
- (B) The compliance must include **IMMEDIATE payment of pension and salary arrears** from July, 2025 till date to these Pak PWD employees (already transferred and those yet to be transferred) from the own resources/budget of the non-compliant Ministries/Divisions/ Departments.
- (III) (A) Considering the extreme hardships faced by these employees the M/o. Finance may cooperate with and guide the concerned Ministries/Divisions/Departments for the settlement of expenditure incurred by these entities as directed in Agenda item (III) (B) above.
- (B) This expenditure must be funded/adjusted/settled **on top priority basis** by the M/o. Finance through **any**

**applicable procedure e.g.** grant-in-aid, technical supplementary grant, re-appropriation of funds from non-Employee Related Expenses to Employee Related Expenses (ERE) & Pension and authorization of such expenditure **with relaxation of quarterly release strategy** on urgent basis.

- (C) The M/o. Finance to provide the list containing relevant details and the discrepancies, if any, in respect of the concerned entities who have demanded funds for the payment of salaries, pensions and the arrears since July, 2025 to these employees.
- (IV) The Accountant General Pakistan Revenue may explain issues hindering payment of salaries, medical bills and related financial matters including loans and advances, GP Fund, Pension Gratuity, etc. to the Maintenance Staff of Pak PWD transferred to Federal Government entities which are on AGPR payroll and provide details of the transferred employees/pensioners whose financial issues/payments are pending with AGPR listing name, designation, grade and current department of the employee, nature/type of payment, date of pendency and the reasons thereof.
- (V) Briefing by the Secretary M/o. Interior and the Chairman CDA on the issue of payment of **pension** and retirement related benefits to the Pak PWD Maintenance Staff transferred to CDA in pursuance of the Federal Cabinet decision.
- (3) Briefing by the Chairman CDA, Ministries of Interior, Planning and Finance on following projects of the former Pak PWD (discussed in various meetings of the Committee):
- (I) Current status of the 5 lifts of Shaheed-e-Millat Secretariat and the latest position of replacement and repair works of the same including the issue of allocation of funds by the concerned Ministries.
- (II) Latest situation of the construction works of Islamabad Model Jail, expected date of completion of the project and the issue of release of funds by the concerned Ministries.
- (4) Details of efforts made by the M/o. Housing & Works to procure ownership documents/record of Chamba House, Lahore from the Pak PWD and the Punjab Government. Opinion/clarification sought from the M/o. Law and Justice and the Cabinet Division regarding status of the "Central Government" including any record/correspondence which implies or indicates/hints to the status of "Central Government" being the Federal Government.
- (5) Finalization of Report on the **Starred Question No.6** asked by **Senator Shahadat Awan** in the Senate Sitting held on 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 regarding "*Name and address of the retired Government officers who are currently occupying Government accommodation in Islamabad along with the amount of rent outstanding against such occupants.*" referred by the House to the Committee for consideration and report within 60 days.
- (6) Finalization of Report on the **Starred Question No. 69** asked by **Senator Mohammad Humayun Mohmand** in the Senate sitting held on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 (regarding details of bidding process for the award of contract of Lifestyle Residency project) referred by the House to the Committee for consideration and report within 60 days.
- (7) Any other matter(s) with permission of the Chair.
