
REVISED NOTICE

A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Federal Education and Professional Training will be held on **Tuesday, 16th June, 2026 at 2:30 p.m.** in Committee Room No. 3 Parliament House Islamabad,

2. The **AGENDA** before the Committee would be as under:-

- i) Detailed discussion on Private Member's Bill titled "The Iqra Global University Bill, 2026 moved by Senator Mohammad Abdul Qadir in Senate sitting on 11th May, 2026.
- ii) Discussion on **Question No, 53** raised by Senator Jan Muhammad in Senate sitting on 15th May, 2026 regarding
 - The total number of Private Educational Institutes registered with Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Authority (PIERA) in the Islamabad Capital Territory, along with the names and complete addresses of all such institutions.
 - The total enrolled strength of each registered private educational institute/School in the Islamabad Capital Territory for the academic year 2025-26, and the details of students admitted free of cost in each institution under the 10% quota as mandated by the section 10 of the right to free and compulsory Education Act, 2012; and
 - The measure taken by the Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training to ensure effective implementation and monitoring of the mandatory 10% free education provision in Private Educational Institution in the Federal Capital, and the details of action taken or proposed to be taken against institution found to be in violation of the said act?.
- iii) Comprehensive briefing by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) regarding the attestation of degrees, with particular reference to the complaints raised during the recent meeting. The briefing may include details of the total number of degrees attested, the status of pending cases, the timeline for their clearance, if any, and a breakdown of the various facilitation mechanisms and services being provided to students for degree attestation and verification.
- iv) Briefing by IBCC on its attestation mechanism, timelines, and status of processed, pending, and delayed cases, including reasons for pendency and remedial measures. The briefing shall also cover the recent A-Level paper leakage incident, complaints received, investigations conducted, accountability measures taken, and steps to prevent future occurrences.
- v) Discussion on the report of the Sub-Committee regarding the agenda item forwarded by Senator Rana Mahmood-ul-Hassan concerning the functioning, transparency, financial management, selection criteria, third-party evaluation mechanisms, and performance outcomes of the National Vocational and Technical Training Commission (NAVITC) during the past five years.
- vi) The Director General, Directorate General of Special Education (DGSE), shall brief the Committee on the policy framework, eligibility criteria, approval process, number of cases facilitated, implementation challenges, and measures taken to ensure timely and transparent provision of writer facilities, including progress on issues raised in the previous meeting
- vii) Briefing and discussion on plagiarism, its prevalence in the education sector, its adverse impact on academic performance and integrity, and the challenges and negative consequences it poses for students, educational institutions, and the overall quality of education.
- viii) Review of the implementation status of the recommendations adopted by the Committee in its previous meeting, including progress made, actions taken by the concerned authorities, and any pending matters requiring further consideration.
- ix) Any other item with the permission of the Chair.


