A meeting/visit of Senate Standing Committee on Petroleum will be held on 29th & 30th June, 2026 at Karachi, Sindh as per following schedule, however, re-revised agenda before the Committee meeting would be as under: -

Visit to the LNG Terminal Site on 29th June, 2026 at 11:30 a.m.

Visit of the site of LNG Terminal, Karachi and detailed briefing on its operational status and performance, terminal capacity and utilization, staff position and organizational structure, operational efficiency and a comprehensive account of any irregularities, audit observations, operational deficiencies, accountability proceedings, and remedial measures undertaken by the management to ensure transparency, efficiency and uninterrupted LNG supply.

Meeting in PSO Headquarters on 30th June, 2026 at 02:00 p.m.

1. Briefing by PSO on its role, operational performance, effectiveness of fuel supply management in context with the prevailing Gulf war situation, future strategy, and corrective measures to improve institutional performance to ensure uninterrupted petroleum supplies.
2. Briefing on alleged undue favor non-merit based promotions, manipulation of performance ratings, and irregular appointment of Acting CEO/CFO in SSGC LPG Limited in violation of the SOEs Act, 2023.
3. Scrutiny of the Public Sector Development Program (PSDP) (2026-27, proposals of the Petroleum Division including project prioritization, fund allocations, implementation strategy, physical and financial progress, and alignment with national energy sector objectives.
4. "Briefing by Petroleum Division on the constitution of the new Board of Directors of Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC), including provincial representation, nomination of members, and details of major decisions taken by the previous Board during its tenure. The division shall provide the rational and legal basis for the one-year extension granted to the incumbent Managing Director and clarify whether such extension was made in accordance with applicable laws, rules, regulations, and principles of merit, without adversely affecting the rights, seniority, and promotional prospects of eligible officers".
5. Briefing by the Petroleum Division on the state of the downstream petroleum sector, with particular reference to the financial impact of the petroleum price reduction of 19th June, 2026, the stability of the pricing mechanism, outstanding Petroleum Development Cess, and measures to restore investor confidence.
6. Briefing by the Chairman, OGRA, on outstanding Price Differential Claims (PDC) of Oil Marketing Companies, with particular reference to the delay in settlement, the revised Terms of Reference, and the methodology for computation of claims.
7. Briefing by MD PARCO on the following: -
 - i. Investigation report by Inquiry Committee lead by Commissioner Multan dated 06-02-2025 on fatal accident of LPG tanker causing dozens of deaths and huge number of disabilities other than damage to private properties & animals. CEO PARCO Pearl Gas & MD PARCO are advised to give a comprehensive briefing on short term, medium term & long-term measures as per report to avoid any such reoccurrences by PPGL. Meanwhile details of compensation paid by PARCO Pearl Gas Ltd to the deceased families through OGRA's decision in which PPGL has been convicted & penalty has been imposed on unlawful conduct & unsafe practices. Meanwhile rehabilitation efforts made by PARCO for disabled, dead animals & damaged buildings due to LPG bowser explosion. Meanwhile how come CEO PPGL got promoted by MD PARCO after being convicted in such a huge national disaster under his area of responsibility?
 - ii. The details of PARCO Rs 225 Million budget utilized for Musical dinners in 2025-26 for 1500 employees & their families in austerity observing era in Pakistan. Meanwhile details of sponsorship amounts given by MD PARCO to different organizations to be submitted along with approved company policy & authorization mechanism.
 - iii. Details of PARCO sponsored facilities, vehicles, staff & fuel cards given to officers of Petroleum Division along with company policy guidelines.
 - iv. The details & No of Advisors appointed by PARCO at ISD, LHR & Karachi for MD PARCO & their financial impact and utilization. Meanwhile share PARCO succession policy for retiring leadership employs as mostly continue working on contract without letting the succession process to be effectively in place.

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- vii. Recent Reports on Intelligent pigging report/ Inspection of pipeline Division which is extensively pumping the relevant products. External reports on Intelligent pigging are mandatory to ascertain health, safety & Health of Pipeline Division PARCO. Last 05 pigging inspection reports & recommendations to be submitted
 - viii. What is the average experience & criteria required for promotion as General Manager in PARCO Vs detail of recently recruited GM Human Resource with 17 years of total experience? Submit her age, experience details, qualifications & salary comparison with other GMs serving since 32 years or more?
 - ix. Status of PARCO occupied 1800 Acres Baluchistan Government land in Hubb District and its legal status as per revenue records.
 - x. Favoritism trail of Mr. Annan Wafi Qureshi (Manager) during last 2.6 Years, with details of his unauthorized leaves of a year, having 05 transfers and details of his present job description in Islamabad office as special envoy of MD PARCO.
 - xi. Review of commitments made by MD PARCO in last senate standing committee at CHQ PARCO to multiply CSR PARCO endeavors & to establish a piece of art Vocational Training College in Ibrahim Haidari at 50th Anniversary of PARCO as none of VTC had been made by PARCO in last 50 years.
 - xii. MD PARCO's leading the activities of women cricket tournaments in CHQ PARCO stadium, who were wearing sports slim suits in the presence of all male spectators' employees of PARCO which is against the ethical values of Islam & Pakistan. Please share Company approved policy of such co-sports tournaments culture admissible at PARCO Office Stadium office premises. Meanwhile pictorial glimpses of female players & male audience in huge crowd should be presented to committee to comprehend the justified actions.
