REVISED NOTICE

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 30th June, 2026, regarding the meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Cabinet Secretariat scheduled to be held on 6th July, 2026 at 11:30 a.m. at the OGRA Headquarters, Islamabad. It is hereby notified that the venue of the meeting has been changed. The meeting shall now be held in **Committee Room No. 2080, 2nd Floor, Establishment Division, Islamabad**, on the same date and at the same time.

2. The **agenda** before the Committee would be as under:-

i. Further consideration of the Government Bill titled "the Civil Servants (Amendment) Bill, 2026 as passed by National Assembly, moved by the Minister for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Senator Ahad Khan Cheema, Minister for Economic Affairs/Establishment in the Senate sitting held on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2026.

ii. **Briefing by the Chairman, OGRA, on the following:**

a) Alleged illegal sale/transfer of bonded petroleum products by M/s Gas & Oil Pakistan Limited (GO Petroleum) and M/s Terminal One Limited, causing reported loss of duties, taxes and petroleum levy to the national exchequer:

- i. Role and responsibility of OGRA in monitoring licensed oil marketing companies, storage facilities, bonded terminals, stock movement, product availability, and compliance with licence conditions.
- ii. Whether any OGRA, or other government officials facilitated, ignored, or failed to detect the alleged irregularities, and what departmental proceedings or criminal action has been initiated against them.
- iii. Details of the regulatory and digital monitoring systems presently used for tracking imported petroleum products from vessel discharge to bonded tanks, pipeline transfer, upcountry storage, ex-bonding and final market sale.
- iv. Reasons for failure of real-time reconciliation between Customs records, terminal stock records, pipeline transfer data, OGRA reporting, and OMC sales/dispatch data.
- v. Measures proposed to prevent recurrence, including mandatory real-time digital stock monitoring, joint OGRA-Customs-FIA inspections, integration of terminal/pipeline data with FBR systems, third-party audits of bonded petroleum storage, and stricter penalties for illegal sale of bonded petroleum products. Top of Form.

b) Details regarding "Outstanding Price Differential Claims (PDCs) as per following:

i. Payable to each OMC, in below format:

- a. Name of OMC
- b. Period/month to which the claim relates
- c. Product-wise claim amount, including petrol, high speed diesel and other applicable petroleum products
- d. Quantity sold/stock considered for claim
- e. Amount claimed by the OMC
- f. Amount verified by OGRA/Petroleum Division
- g. Amount disallowed/deferred, if any, along with reasons
- h. Amount paid to date
- i. Outstanding balance payable
- j. Date of submission of claim and date of verification/approval

ii. Product-wise and OMC-wise details of the stock cut-off date used for calculating PDC claims, including whether the claim is based on opening stock, closing stock,

sales during the pricing period, or stock held at depots/retail outlets on the relevant cut-off date.

- iii. Analysis of delays in payment against committed timelines, identification of systemic bottlenecks and responsibility for implementation gaps, and consideration of a permanent mechanism for timely settlement to ensure uninterrupted fuel supply and maintain investor confidence.
  - c) Unauthorized/overnight change of Oil Marketing Company at retail outlet sites by landlords/dealers without following due process:
    - i. Legal and regulatory procedure for change of OMC/brand at an existing retail outlet, including requirement of prior approval, NOC, notice period, safety clearance and updated licence documentation.
    - ii. OMC-wise details of cases during the last three years where landlords/dealers removed or replaced an OMC overnight without lawful termination, notice or plausible reason.
    - iii. Action taken by OGRA against landlords/dealers and incoming OMCs where site takeover occurred without settlement of dues, NOC from outgoing OMC, stock reconciliation, safety inspection or regulatory approval.
    - iv. Measures required to protect OMC investments in tanks, dispensing units, canopy, signage, civil works, automation and product supply arrangements.
    - v. Proposal for a clear SOP making prior OGRA intimation/approval, outgoing OMC NOC, settlement of dues and safety verification mandatory before any change of OMC/brand at a retail outlet site.
  - iii. Briefing by the Chairman, OGRA, on Complaint No.922/2025 and Appeal No. 46/2025 against Mr. Shahzad Munir having Consumer No. 36971641638.
  - iv. **Briefing by the Secretaries Establishment Division and Ministry of Finance Division on the following:**
