A meeting of the Sub-Committee of the Senate Standing Committee on Interior and Narcotics Control will be held on **Monday, 13th July 2026, at 2:00 p.m. in Committee Room No. 4, Parliament House, Islamabad.** **In case of a Senate Session, the meeting will be postponed.**

2. The agenda before the **Sub-Committee** would be as under: -

“To examine the effectiveness of border security mechanisms at key entry points, including the Sost Border, Pak-China Customs posts, seaports, dry ports and airports, with particular focus on coordination among FBR/Customs, the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA), the Anti-Narcotics Force (ANF), and other relevant agencies in preventing the smuggling of narcotics, FATA, PATA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Balochistan and to review action taken against officials found complicit in such networks; to review the custody, inventory, and disposal of narcotics, contraband goods, confiscated vehicles, and other seized assets held in FBR/Customs godowns and warehouses, including an audit of stock register, investigation of fire incidents, during the last ten years for possible criminal culpability or destruction of evidence, and coordination with the FIA, ANF, and police authorities to identify malpractices, leakages and fix responsibility on delinquent officials; and to prevent smuggling, narcotics trafficking, and corruption at border and customs posts, including recovery of the estimated USD 1 billion in the tax evasion attributed to the tobacco industry.”
