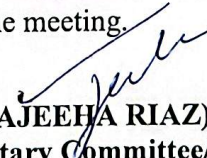
NOTICE

A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Information & Broadcasting will be held on **23rd July, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. at PTV Headquarter, Islamabad.**

2. The agenda of the meeting would be as under:-

- i) Film Certification/ Censor Board members and producers of the film "Buleha" to brief the Committee on the censor process and discussions on the film, in continuation of points 4 and 5 of the last agenda.
- ii) NCCIA to clarify discrepancy as per point 1 of the last agenda regarding concerns raised on social media statistics and figures shared with the Senate Standing Committee and later disowned by NCCIA.
- iii) NCCIA to provide details about FIRs/ cases transferred to it from provinces under PECA as provinces no longer have jurisdiction over offences under PECA.
- iv) To discuss the concerns raised in continuation of agenda item 8 of the last meeting as per the letter written by executive editor of daily Pakistan about cases being registered on columns and news appearing in newspapers and their websites by NCCIA office bearers of the Pakistan Administrative Services Association-Punjab Chapter to be asked to explain the complaint filed by them at NCCIA.
- v) Briefing on the allotment of plots and flats by the Federal Government Employees Housing Authority to journalists and media workers separately under the reserved quota since 1st January, 2015 to date, including the applicable quota/ policy, utilization thereof, and the status of pending applications/ cases.
- vi) Briefing regarding the allocation of Federal Government advertisements to regional newspapers, including the causes of their consistently low share in government advertising, the policy and criteria governing advertisement distribution, and the corrective measures being taken to ensure equitable representation and fair allocation to regional newspapers, Ministry of information to provide province wise data on advertisements released to regional newspapers during 2025-26.
- vii) Any other agenda item with the permission of the Chair.
