- i. Briefing on the latest developments regarding Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs), Pakistan's endangered cryosphere, and its associated emerging challenges.
- ii. A detailed briefing by the Secretary, Ministry of Climate Change and Environmental Coordination, on all PSDP-funded projects under the Ministry, including project-wise allocations, releases, expenditures, physical and financial progress, outcomes achieved, and utilization of funds for climate adaptation, mitigation, biodiversity conservation, forestry, and environmental protection projects during FY 2025-26 and FY 2026-27.
- iv. A detailed briefing by the Secretary, Ministry of Climate Change and Environmental Coordination, on the National Drought Action Plan, including its formulation, implementation status, institutional arrangements, allocation and utilization of funds, rainwater harvesting initiatives, drought preparedness measures, early warning systems, and coordination mechanisms with provincial governments for drought mitigation and climate resilience.
- v. Briefing by the Secretary, Ministry of Climate Change, along with Heads of relevant implementing agencies/stakeholders on progress of rule-making, enforcement status, and actions taken so far for implementation of the Islamabad Capital Territory (Prohibitions of Plastic Book Covers) Act, 2026.
- vi. Any other agenda item with the permission of the Chair.

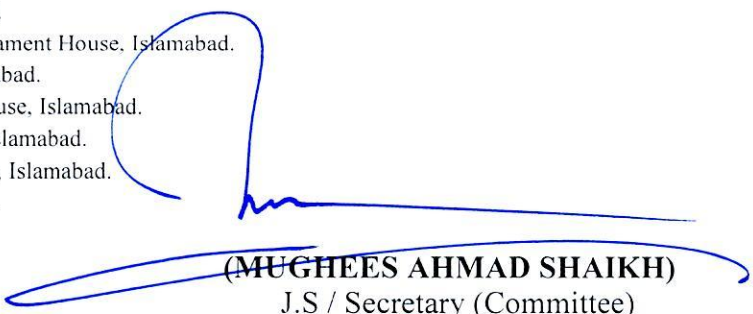
