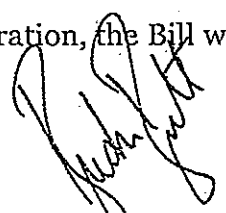

4. The Committee considered the Government Bill seeking amendments to the "National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyin Authority Act, 2022", as introduced in the Senate. The Committee held detailed deliberations on the proposed amendments and carefully examined the salient provisions of the Bill. Following due consideration, the Bill was

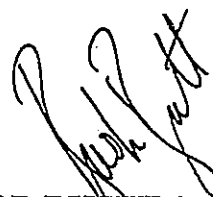


put to a vote and was unanimously adopted by the Committee. Accordingly, the Committee recommended that the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyin Authority (Amendment) Bill, 2026 be passed by the Senate.

BILL

to amend the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalamoon Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalamoon Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022 (XV of 2022), in the manner and for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act shall be called the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalamoon Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority (Amendment) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3, Act XV of 2022.—In the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalamoon Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022 (XV of 2022), hereinafter referred to as "the said Act" in section 3, in sub-section (3), after the word and comma "members," the words "out of which two shall be female" shall be inserted.

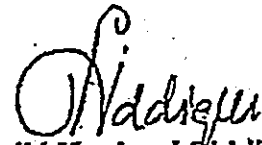
3. Amendment of section 4, Act XV of 2022.—In the said Act, in section 4, in sub-section (2), after the word "members", the comma and words "out of which three shall be female" shall be inserted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECT AND REASONS

Cabinet Division communicated Honorable Prime Minister's directive to ensure "33% women representations in all Federal Boards, Statutory Bodies, Public Sector Organizations, and Allied Committees under the Federal Government (Task No. T16367C)" & substitute the word "Federal Government" with the "appropriate authority" in relevant laws and rules of the departments under the preview of the Ministries/Divisions. In order to ensure compliance of the above directive, Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training has started process of making necessary amendments in the existing laws / charters of the National Rahamtul-Il-Aalameen Wa Khalamun Nabiyyun Authority (NRKNA) Act, 2022 under the ambit of the Ministry.

2. There is a dire need to bring adequate amendments in the existing National Rahamtul-Il-Aalameen Wa Khalamun Nabiyyun Authority (NRKNA) Act, 2022. The Bill seeks to achieve the aforesaid objects.
