REVISED NOTICE

A meeting of the Senate Functional Committee on Human Rights scheduled to be held on 3rd September 2026 at 1:30 p.m. in Committee Room No. 1, Parliament House, Islamabad, will now be held on Wednesday, 9th September 2026, in Old PIPS Hall, Parliament Lodges, Islamabad at 11:30 a.m.

2. The agenda before the Committee would remain the same, as under: -
- i). Detailed briefing on the death of 14 newborn babies at PIMS due to the administrative and systematic negligence, with particular reference to the fundamental obligation to guarantee right of life and the right to the highest attainable standards of health facilities to the citizens, lack of safety measures, management oversight, shortcomings along with initiatives to be taken to prevent such incidents in future.
 - ii). Further briefing on issues of sanitary workers with special reference to the recent suicide of sanitary worker Zeeshan due to payment of half salary in Gujranwala, pursuant to the directions given by the Committee in its meeting held on 17th July, 2026.
 - iii). Further briefing on protective measures being taken by the government to eliminate the menace of child begging, pursuant to the directions given by the Committee in its meeting held on 17th July, 2026.
 - iv). Further briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Punjab and Chief Secretary, Punjab on the investigation and prosecution status of Jaranwala incident of 16th August, 2023, outlining the initial number of accused versus the accused who were actually tried and prosecuted, sentences awarded, if any, status of compensation to the affected families, along with reports submitted in the courts as directed by the Committee in its meeting held on 8th July, 2026.
 - v). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Punjab, regarding investigation in the murder case of Hina Javed, in Askari Rawalpindi, on 22nd August, 2026, with particular reference to the performance of local police, progress in arresting the real culprits and measures taken so far or being taken by the police to ensure fair, transparent and expeditious investigation to provide justice to the bereaved family.
 - vi). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Islamabad, regarding investigation in the murder case of Hina Zareef within the jurisdiction of Nilore Police Station, Islamabad on 13th August, 2026, in the name of honor killing, as a result of her denial to continue a marriage she had entered against her will.
 - vii). Further briefing by the DG, NCCIA on the FIR of complaint of Mr. Tahir Nawaz s/o Asghar Nawaz against Mr. Sheraz Nisar s/o Nisar Asghar, concerning alleged campaign of derogatory remarks against his family on social media pursuant to the Committee's directions made in its meeting held on 17th July, 2026.
 - viii). Further consideration of Point of Public importance raised by Senator Rana Mehmood ul Hassan in the Senate in its sitting held on 13th November 2025, regarding target killing of a person (Ahmed Javed S/O Adil Rasheed of Central Group of Colleges, Pakistan) in DHA Phase-9, Lahore, referred to the Committee for consideration and report.

- ix). a). Further briefing by Inspector General of Police, Sindh, regarding alleged delay in investigation in the murder case of Dr. Safdar Rajput in village Radhan, District Dadu, pursuant to the directions made by the Committee in its meeting held on 17th July, 2026.
- b). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Sindh, on the murder case of Mir Raza Ali Khan, a 25-year-old IBA graduate who was found shot dead in Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Karachi, on July 29, 2026, with particular reference to the performance of local police, progress in arresting the real culprits and measures taken so far or being taken by the police to ensure fair, transparent and expeditious investigation in order to provide justice to the bereaved family.
- x). Comprehensive briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on the following issues:-
- (a) Alleged delay in investigation in the murder case of Syed Amir Shehzad Shah, in village Bherkund, District Mansehra, on 7th July, 2026, with particular reference to the performance of local police, progress in arresting the real culprits and measures taken so far or being taken by the police to ensure fair, transparent and expeditious investigation in order to provide justice to the bereaved family; and
- (b) Murder of a five-year-old Ayat Noor, resident of Haripur, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, who was abducted 15 days ago and reportedly been killed after sexually assault by five suspects.
