A meeting of the Senate Functional Committee on Human Rights will be held on 16th September 2026, at 11:30 a.m. in Committee Room No. 4, Parliament House, Islamabad.

2. The agenda before the Committee would be as under: -

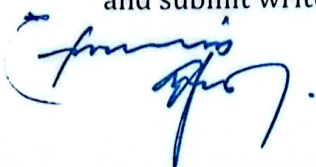
i). Further briefing on the death of 14 newborn babies at PIMS due to administrative and systematic negligence, with particular reference to the fundamental obligation to guarantee the right to life and the right to the highest attainable standards of health facilities to citizens; lack of safety measures, management oversight, shortcomings allowing initiatives to be taken to prevent such incidents in future, pursuant to directions of the Committee in its meeting held on 9th September, 2026.

ii). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Islamabad, regarding investigation in the murder case of Hina Zareef within the jurisdiction of Nilore Police Station, Islamabad, on 13th August, 2026, in the name of honour killing; and the result of her denial to continue a marriage she had entered against her will, pursuant to directions made by the Committee in its meeting held on 9th September, 2026.

iii). Further briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Punjab and D.G. NCCIA, on the cases concerning the target killing of Ahmed Javed in DHA Phase-9, Lahore and social-media campaign against the bereaved family as contained in the FIR registered by complainant Mr. Tahir Nawaz. The concerned authorities shall submit the latest investigation and prosecution status, details of bail granted or pending, relevant court orders, and item-wise implementation status of the Committee's previous directions and recommendations.

iv). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Police, Sindh, on the murder case of Mir Raza Ali Khan, a 25-year-old IBA graduate who was found shot dead in Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Karachi, on 29th July, 2026, with particular reference to the performance of local police, progress in arresting the real culprits, and measures taken to ensure a fair, transparent and expeditious investigation and justice to the bereaved family. An updated investigation report shall be placed before the Committee.

v). Detailed briefing by the Secretary, Home and Tribal Affairs Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Inspector General of Police, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, RPO Hazara, DPO Haripur and the Investigating Officer regarding the rape and murder of five-year-old Ayat Noor in Haripur, including the missing-person report and FIR chronology, search and recovery operation, arrest and custody of the accused, forensic and medical evidence, prosecution progress, protection of the victim's family, and action taken against any officer responsible for delay or negligence. Relevant child-protection and prosecution authorities shall also attend and submit written reports.



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vi). Detailed briefing by the Inspector General of Punjab Police, CCPO Lahore, and SP concerned regarding the reported gang-rape case in Model Town, Lahore, including the FIR and investigation chronology, preservation and examination of CCTV and forensic evidence, arrest and custody status of the accused, protection and medical and legal support provided to the survivor, and action against any negligence. An updated police report shall be submitted to the Committee.

vii). Detailed briefing by the Chief Secretary Balochistan, Inspector General of Balochistan Police, Secretary Home, Secretary Social Welfare and Child Protection, and concerned district police officers regarding the case of Shukria Bibi, wife of Kamalan, involving allegations of domestic violence and early marriage in the New Kuchlak area of Quetta; including her safety and present status, registration and investigation of the case, medical and legal assistance, age verification, protection from further violence, and action taken under the applicable child-marriage and criminal laws. A joint updated report shall be placed before the Committee.

viii). Briefing from Inspector General of Sindh Police on the sexual assault and murder of the 18-month-old girl in Qayyumabad, Karachi, outlining the FIR, post-mortem, DNA and forensic examination, custody status, investigation progress and protection provided to the family.

ix). Any other item with permission of the Chair.

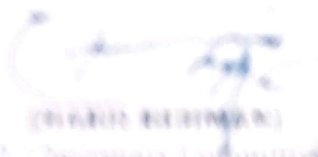
