- b) A Private Secretary in (B-17),
- c) A Stenographer in (B-15),
- d) A Driver in (B-4), and
- e) A Naib Qasid in (B-1).

Free Travel

- a) Travel Vouchers of the value of Rs.300,000 per year or *
- b) Cash in lieu of Travel Vouchers Rs.90,000 per year.

c) Twenty business class open return air tickets.

Traveling Allowance

Journey by Rail

An amount equal to the aggregate of one air-conditioned class fare and one second class fare,

Journey by Air

An amount equal to the aggregate of

one business class air fare and one hundred and fifty rupees, and

Journey by Road

Mileage allowance at the rate of ten rupees per kilometer.

Note: - The traveling allowance in respect of a journey between two stations shall be admissible on the basis of the shortest of the practicable routes between those stations.

Daily Allowance and Housing Allowance for attending the Senate Session or meeting of a Committee at the following rates per day for the period of *residence on duty:-

*Daily Allowance ordinary rate (w.e.f 01.08.2012)	Rs.1,750
*Daily Allowance Special rate (w.e.f 01.08.2012)	Rs. 3,000
Conveyance allowance (w.e.f 01.07.2014)	Rs. 2,000

*Residence on duty means stay at the place where session or committee meeting is held:-

- a) upto period not exceeding three days before the commencement of session and three days following the end of session, and
- b) upto period not exceeding two days before the commencement of a sitting of the committee and two days after the conclusion of the sittings of a committee.

Telephone Facility

Installation of telephone at the residence at Islamabad at Government expense and exemption of rental and payment of charges of calls up to a maximum of five thousand rupees per month.

Free Medical Facility

Office Accommodation

- (i) Free office accommodation with necessary furniture & equipment;
- (ii) Telephone facility in the office to a limit of ten thousand rupees per month;
- (iii) Services of P.S, Stenographer, Driver & Naib Qasid;
- (iv) 1300 CC Car and 360 litres of petrol per month for local use.
- (v) Allowed to use car beyond the municipal limits of Islamabad within the prescribed ceiling of 360 litres of petrol per month. However, he will hire private driver for the journey conducted outside Islamabad.
