Around the world, lack of access to quality and affordable childcare represents a key barrier to women securing and remaining in employment. Sir, basically it is to increase the number of women in the factories. Sir, I think, it is self-explanatory.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Tarar Sahib, can we proceed with the bill?

Mr. Presiding Officer: We now take up second reading of the Bill that is Clause by Clause consideration of the Bill. There is no amendment in Clause 2. So, I put the Clause before the House. The question is that Clause 2 do form part of the Bill?

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clause 2 stands part of the Bill. Now, we take up Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title of the Bill. The question is that Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title of the Bill do form part of the Bill?

Mr. Presiding Officer: The motion is carried and Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, stands part of the Bill. Order No. 13, it is also in the name of Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri.

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: I, Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri move that the Bill further to amend the Factories Act, 1934 [The Factories (Amendment) Bill, 2023], be passed.

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: Sir, we have gone through a very detailed discussion on all of these.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clauses 2 and 3 stand part of the Bill. We may now, take up Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title of the Bill. The question is that Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, do stand part of the Bill?

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, stands part of the Bill. Now, we move on to Order No.19.

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: I move that the Bill further to amend the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 [The Guardians and Wards (Amendment) Bill, 2024], be passed.

Mr. Presiding Officer: I now put the motion before the House.

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: The Bill stands passed. Now, we come to Order No.20 which is again in the name of Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clauses 2 to 46 including 10A, 13A, 19A and First Statute stand part of the Bill. We may now take up clause 6A of the Bill. There is an amendment in clause 6A in the name of Senator Fawzia Arshad. Please move the amendment.

Senator Fawzia Arshad: I would like to move that clause 6A of the Bill may be substituted as under:-

“6A” Jurisdiction: The Principal seat of the university shall be at Islamabad and it may setup any number of campuses, colleges and institutes at such places in Pakistan and abroad as may be determined by the Board of Governors subject to prior approval of the Higher Education Commission.”

Mr. Presiding Officer: Now I put the amendment before the House.

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: The amendment is carried. Now I put clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, as amended. The question is that clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, as amended, do form part of the Bill?

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, as amended, stands part of the Bill. We are just to close the agenda. OK. Order No. 27. Senator Rana Mahmood ul Hassan may move Order No. 27. On his behalf Senator Fawzia Arshad, please move Order No. 27. You are also mover of the Bill.

Senator Fawzia Arshad: I wish to move that the Bill to provide for the establishment of Wapda University Islamabad [The Wapda University Islamabad Bill, 2024], be passed.

Mr. Presiding Officer: I now put the motion before the House.

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: The motion is adopted and the Bill stands passed. Order No. 28. Senator Kamran Murtaza Sahib may move Order No. 28, please.

Senator Kamran Murtaza: Sir, it is moved that the Bill to constitute the Pakistan Animal Science Council in Pakistan [The Pakistan Animal Science Council Bill, 2023], as reported by the Standing Committee, be taken into consideration at once.

Mr. Presiding Officer: The Schedule-I stands part of the Bill. I now put Schedule-II to the vote of the House. There is no amendment in Schedule-II. The question is that Schedule-II do form part of the Bill?

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: Schedule-II stands part of the Bill. We may now take up clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, of the Bill. The question is that clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, do form part of the Bill?

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: Clause 1, the Preamble and the Title, stands part of the Bill. Order No. 29. Senator Kamran Murtaza, please move Order No. 29.

Senator Kamran Murtaza: It is moved that the Bill to constitute the Pakistan Animal Science Council in Pakistan [The Pakistan Animal Science Council Bill, 2023], be passed.

Mr. Presiding Officer: I now put the motion before the House.

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: The motion is adopted and the Bill stands passed unanimously. Thank you. Order No. 30. Senator Fawzia Arshad may move Order No. 30.

Withdrawal of [The General Clauses (Amendment) Bill, 2024]

Senator Fawzia Arshad: Thank you. I seek leave to withdraw the Bill further to amend the General Clauses Act, 1897 [The General Clauses (Amendment) Bill, 2024] as introduced in the Senate on 29th April, 2024.

Mr. Presiding Officer: I now put the motion before the House.

(The motion was carried)

Mr. Presiding Officer: The motion is carried and the leave to withdraw the Bill is granted. Order No. 31, Senator Fawzia Arshad.

Senator Fawzia Arshad: I would like to withdraw the Bill further to amend the General Clauses Act, 1897 [The General Clauses (Amendment) Bill, 2024].

Mr. Presiding Officer: The Bill stands withdrawn. Order No. 32 stands the name of Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri, please move the resolution.

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: Before I move the resolution, I want to say something about my previous Bills. My colleague and my brother, I have a lot of respect for Senator Azam Nazeer Tarar Sahib but I would also like to request one thing

Resolution moved by Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri regarding the increasing number of loss of innocent lives and injuries due to motorcycle accidents in the country

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: I would like to move the following resolution:-

“Cognizant of the increasing number of loss of innocent lives and injuries due to motorcycle accidents in the country;

Mindful of the fact that lack of safety features in motorbikes and poor quality helmets are one of the main causes of these fatal accidents;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends that the government should ensure that manufacturers of motorcycles and helmets must equip their finished products with all the safety features at par with international standards and regulate this regime through enforcement of quality assurance mechanism.”

Sir! this resolution I brought forward because obviously there is also right of riders and that comes under the right of way but along with that reason the most important resolution why I bought this since was

because in one of my committees I raised the question why there are so many accidents taking place? It was a different topic but then obviously our traffic officers recommend this that the manufacturers of motorbikes are not installing the features properly like the side mirrors are not properly installed, they are removable, so people remove those accessories from it, helmets are not provided properly, the gear is not given. This needs to be ensured and there is so much inflation that everybody now-a-days majority you can see on the roads, a whole family, husband wife three four kids,

Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri: I would like to move the following resolution:-

“Cognizant of the fact that a large number of children in Pakistan have unknown parentage which

cannot be ascertained except from an Identity Card. And the existing NADRA ID cards are devoid of this feature. Therefore, it is very important to direct NADRA to include this column in ID Card features;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends that the government may issue necessary directions in this regard to direct NADRA for including a separate column for “Majhool-un-nasab” children on an ID Card.”

This is for the children who don't have and who don't know who their fathers and parents are and they are thrown. Nowadays, it happens a lot and this is a part of my Committee also where this was raised that there are nearly about 180 million Pakistanis but only half of them exist legally and which confirms that their identity as legal citizens of Pakistan entitles them to basic rights such as equality of status, access to economic and political justice, and freedom of expression of belief and worship. With a rapidly growing population, these innumerable identity less Pakistanis have faded certainly into the background so, this is very important.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Thank you. Is it opposed?

Mr. Attaullah Tarar (Minister for Information and Broadcasting)

Mr. Attaullah Tarar (Minister for Information and Broadcasting): I would like to make a certain clarification. Thank you for raising this issue. This is a very important issue and I would like to thank the honourable Senator for raising it. It was first raised by Late Abdul Sattar Edhi in 2011 and it has been endorsed by the Supreme Court of Pakistan in a Human Rights petition. Sir, right now NADRA has an existing policy of registering such children without parentage.

سینئر شمیمہ ممتاز زہری: منسٹر صاحب کا بہت شکریہ کہ انہوں نے یہ add کیا and adding to my knowledge, was it 2011? Ok, since 2011 to 2024, we have been sitting on this. Sir, Supreme Court ordered transfer and we are worried about the discrimination! you said? Ok, stigma, just to add to the knowledge of my colleagues here, like he added to mine that in 2011 late Eidhi Sahib has said this which was very nice of him, and I think that this should have been implemented then and there.

Sir, we all are the property of the State, aren't we? So why can't we be owned and just because of the supposed discrimination, which we continuously and already have, so anything can happen. Sir, he, she, he transgender, she transgender has already been mentioned on the bank statements, so what discrimination are we talking about.
